




#### **A Picnic**


Hi Gordon,






#### **A Football Match**

# **Boston Central Library**

Welcome to one of the oldest public libraries in America. The Boston Central Library is located in two beautiful buildings. The classical **McKim Building** is in Dartmouth Street. It was



started in 1888 and was completed seven years later, in 1895, when the library there was finally opened. In that year, people could choose from nearly 450,000 books to borrow. The modern **Johnson Building** is around the corner in Boylston Street and opened in 1972. Now, the Boston Central Library has over 20 million books and other materials to lend.

The **McKim Building** includes some wonderful art and architecture. The famous Bates Hall is still used for studying and reading. It has high ceilings and windows with green curtains. The lamps of the same colour, together with the brown bookcases, look unusual.

The **Johnson Building** offers a variety of books on the first and second floors. The CDs and DVDs are on the second floor, next to the room where you can find magazines. On the third floor, you can borrow newspapers and maps.

#### **Guided Tours of the Library:**

Come for a guided tour of the library. You do not need a ticket, but please bring your library card because you need it to join the tour. The tour begins daily in front of the Johnson Building and ends in nearby Copley Square.

#### **Writing Workshops:**

Next month, the Boston Central Library organises these writing workshops:

**Stage Plays:** \$90, on Saturday, 8<sup>th</sup> June at 8:30 a.m., 9 hours long

**Short Stories:** \$80, on Sunday, 9<sup>th</sup> June at 9:00 a.m., 8 hours long

Poetry: \$85, on Saturday, 15th June at 10:00 a.m., 7 hours long

Comics: \$95, on Sunday, 23<sup>rd</sup> June at 9:30 a.m., 8 hours long

You will have a chance to meet the popular writer Olivia Clark, who teaches the workshops on the weekend of 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June. The rest of the workshops are taught by the artist David Morice.


