Perth Running Festival

Do you like running? Join us for the Perth Running Festival in the city of Perth on Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th October 2025! Save these dates in your calendar.



History: The Perth Running Festival is organised by the Perth Sports Club, which started in 1980. The Perth Running Festival began as a one-day festival in 1981 when it included three races. Ten years later, in 1991, the festival added another day with three more races. Today, it offers workshops as well.

Races:

Saturday:	Sunday:
Great Run: 10 km, at 9:30 a.m., for runners who are over 15 years old	Marathon: 42.2 km, at 7:30 a.m., for runners aged 18 and over
Fit Run: 5 km, at 10:30 a.m., for runners of all ages	Half Marathon: 21.1 km, at 9:00 a.m., for runners over the age of 15
Mini Run: 3 km, at 11:00 a.m., for runners who are less than 15 years old	Fun Run: 2 km, at 10:45 a.m., for runners of all ages

All races start and end at Optus Stadium except for the Great Run, which finishes there, but its start is at Langley Park. Part of each race runs along the Swan River.

Perth Running Centre: Please note that you must collect your race number from the centre before your race. The centre is in Riverside Street and it is open daily from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Please arrive at least 30 minutes before the centre's closing time.

What runners get: Complete your race and get a T-shirt as a gift. Some runners may also win running socks after finishing their race. The three fastest runners in each race will receive money as a prize. It will be from \$200 up to \$5,000.

Workshops: Come to the festival's main stage in Burswood Street to enjoy one of our daily workshops, such as Healthy Eating. Our popular Training Advice workshop is only available in the Perth Running Centre. In this workshop, you can learn about the new running app called MyRun, which was created by the famous athlete Noah Limmer. The workshop is taught by his colleague Jeff Higdon, who will show you how to work with the app and how to plan your training for different races.

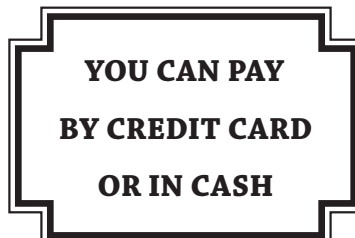
