Bells Language School

Our language school started in 2004 when we offered our first courses for adults. Two years later we opened courses for children and teenagers. And in 2016 we began teaching online. These courses were available for all three age groups and have become quite popular.



Our school is located in two different places in central London. You will find the school office, modern classrooms and a student café at **16 Stukeley Street**. Our exam centre and the school library are both at **31 Newton Street**, which is only a short walk from the main school building.

At our school, you can choose from a variety of English courses for all levels and age groups. This summer we will open several new courses for teenagers. They will take place in our classrooms in Stukeley Street.

Summer Courses for Teenagers:

Reading and Writing (£890, 40 lessons)
• 5 weeks long, lessons every weekday except for Monday (8:30–12:00)
English Grammar (£870, 40 lessons)
• 4 weeks long, lessons from Monday to Friday (8:30–12:00)
Conversation in English (£860, 40 lessons)
• 10 weeks long, lessons on Saturday and Sunday (9:00–12:30)

The summer courses begin in the last week of June. You do not need to buy any textbooks before the course as we will give you one in the first lesson. The textbook is included in the course price. Please do not forget to bring a pen.

Online Language Courses: You can learn a foreign language or improve it online with us. Choose from German, French, Spanish and Italian. We offer online courses for beginners (25 classes, 55 minutes each) and for advanced students (20 classes, 45 minutes each). For both levels, the classes take place twice a week this autumn term.

Autumn Workshops for Teachers: We would like to invite teachers to our exam centre where we are organising interesting workshops this September.

Vocabulary Activities: from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on 11th September.

Classroom Games: from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on 18th September.

Exam Preparation: from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on 25th September.

Please book your place on the workshop at the school office before 1st September.

European Day of Languages: Visit the student café on 26th September to celebrate the European Day of Languages and get a language magazine as a gift. Join us for the afternoon quiz about English-speaking countries and if you answer all questions correctly, you may win an English dictionary as a prize!

Steve Jobs


